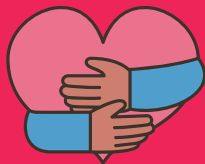

Receive mentoring consistent with the experience the majority of the new principals in Alabama will receive.



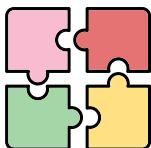
### 6 REGULAR CHECK-INS
